



## 2010-11 Grand Prix Series - Sanction

### Regulations and General Information:

- The 2010-11 Grand Prix Series is open to all currently registered Skate Australia / Skate Victoria Competitive / Platinum and Gold members.
- The competition divisions are ability based and include: Senior A, Senior B, Senior C, Junior A, Junior B, Junior C and Junior D. The Speed Branch Committee will determine which division skaters will compete in and may add, remove or change divisions as required.
- All nominations are to be made through clubs prior to the event, along with the payment of any fees. No nominations will be accepted on the day of the event. Series fees are \$80 prepaid or \$15 per GP.
- All indoor races shall be conducted according to the Australian Speed Rule Book. All outdoor races shall be conducted according to the International Rule Book.
- The maximum wheel diameter allowable is 110mm. However frame and wheel restrictions apply to all Skate Victoria registered competitors, under the age of 14 years as at the 1st January.
- Skaters are required to abide by the following restrictions in order to be eligible to compete:

10 & 11 yrs	100mm	11.25 in 28.58 cm	3 x 100   4 x 90   or below
12 & 13 yrs	100mm	12.50 in 31.80 cm	4 x 100   4 x 90   or below

- Skaters in all divisions will be awarded points, at all Grand Prix events. Points awarded on a per race basis 1st 10pts, 2nd 8pts, 3rd 6pts, 4th 5pts, 5th 4pts, 6th 3pts, 7th 2pts and 1pt for each finisher. No points awarded for any relay races and overall prizes per division to be presented on 30th April at Skaterz Series # 3. Junior B, C and D to receive ribbons for overall, at each Grand Prix event.
- The Speed Branch Committee will fairly determine the number of points a skater will carry into a new division.
- Helmets must be worn at all times while on skates. Gloves must be worn at all times while on skates on the road surface. No exceptions will be made to this rule.
- Any skater, official, coach or spectator who behaves in an inappropriate manner may be disqualified from the competition and/or removed from the venue. Further action may also be taken in accordance with the Skate Victoria By-Law covering Disciplinary Procedures.
- By nominating for any of the above mentioned events, skaters agree to abide by the regulations and conditions outlined in this sanction.
