

## 2009 NATIONAL INSURANCE INFORMATION

The process for making a claim is as follows:-

1. Obtain claim forms by contacting Horsell International or visiting <http://www.horsell.com/SkateAustralia> or [www.skateaustralia.org.au](http://www.skateaustralia.org.au) .
2. Only one claim form (per injury) is required. A claim form should be completed and submitted within 30 days from the date of your injury occurring. You do not have to wait until after you have completed treatment for your injury to lodge your claim form.
3. Please ensure that a General Practitioner, Surgeon, Specialist or Dentist completes the Doctor's Statement. All medical treatment must be certified necessary by a legally qualified medical practitioner.
4. Please enclose all original receipts for non Medicare medical expenses (if applicable). If you are covered by Private Health Insurance, please also include the statement from your Health insurer.
5. Once you have completed the claim form, please send it to Horsell International Pty Ltd.

Please note policy covers non Medicare medical costs incurred as a result of an injury, not as a result medical condition or illness.

### Example

If a competitive member participating in competition/training suffered a heart/attack. They would not be covered unless the heart attack was caused by an accident or injury.

Members participating in competitions/training/meetings outside of their state are not covered for repatriation unless the doctor deems for medical reasons that the patient be transferred to another hospital. Transfer on compassionate grounds is not applicable.

- Air Ambulance is not covered by Private Health Insurance SA National Policy or State based Ambulance coverage.
