First Aid Subsidy Support Requirements

To assist clubs and groups to return to skating post Covid-19, Skate Victoria will provide funding support for members to gain or update their first aid certification for Level 1.

The Skate Victoria First Aid Subsidy support is for the period of 1st January – 31st August each year.

Funding applies to new and refresher certification.

Up to a maximum of \$500 can be applied for by an affiliated club who has met Skate Victoria's compliance requirements.

First Aiders must be current Skate Victoria members.

The Skate Victoria First Aid funding application form is required to be submitted for approval, available here: skatevic.org/FirstAid

Reimbursement payment will only be made on:

- Receipt of First Aid Training Provider paid invoice/s
- Email member certificate of completion

Required documentation needs to be emailed to office@skatevictoria.com.au

Skate Victoria is to be acknowledged via social media for First Aid Subsidy Support.

Clubs and groups may host First Aid courses or their members can gain certification privately through a Recognised Training Organisation of their choice.

Skate Victoria has no preference for First Ais Training Providers.
