Club Registration

The below outlines the Guidelines for Skate Victoria affiliated clubs and providers wishing to run Roller Disco sessions.

Any breach of these guidelines may result in the forfeiture of the clubs or providers right to host another Roller Disco session for the remainder of that affiliated year.

Skate Victoria offer these memberships at no charge (No charge for the individual membership).

Roller Disco sessions are designed to introduce new skaters to roller sports, aid clubs and providers in recruiting members and potentially raise funds for clubs and groups.

Clubs and providers are to apply for a Roller Disco session one (1) month prior to the activity. This can be done through Skate Victoria online form, skatevic.org/RollerDiscoRego. The club/provider will be advised via email that sanctioning has been granted for the Roller Disco session.

Club Responsibilities

Skate Victoria affiliated clubs and providers wishing to hold a Roller Disco session must:

- 1.1. Register online at least one (1) month prior to hosting any Roller Disco session.
- 1.2. Ensure Roller Disco sessions are not being used by clubs or providers as Come and Try, Recreation or training for existing Skate Victoria members.
- 1.3. Ensure the Roller Disco session has at least one (1) accredited coach and one (1) First Aider in attendance before it begins.
- 1.4. Ensure Roller Disco membership is used for these activities and online forms have been completed.
- 1.5. Ensure any injuries must be submitted via the online Incident form within 5 days of the activity.
- 1.6. Nominate a Responsible Person, who will be the primary person Skate Victoria will contact.
- 1.7. To be eligible to apply for SV Roller Disco sanctioning clubs/providers must run other skating activities and have SV registered members.
- 1.8. As per insurer's instructions:
 - i. All participants must sign a waiver of liability which is included in the SV Roller Disco online registration form prior to taking part in the activity being organised by the SV approved affiliated club or independent provider.
 - ii. In respect of persons under 16 years of age, a counter signature by the parent or guardian is mandatory.
 - iii. Documentary evidence – The Skate Victoria online participant registration form will be made available to the Insurer at any time on reasonable notice of the Insurer.
 - iv. In the event of breach of the above conditions by Skate Victoria, Club or Independent Provider, the insurer may reduce or refuse our liability under the Skate Victoria Insurance Policy to the extent of any prejudice suffered by the insurer arising from the breach of the above conditions.

Participant Registration

Participant's insurance is free of charge if requirements are met and sanctioning to run the Roller Disco session is received via email.

Participants may attend multiple Roller Disco events but are required to submit Skate Victoria Roller Disco Membership form each time they attend.

Participant Requirements

All skaters must complete the online form: skatevic.org/RollerDisco before they commence the Roller Disco session.
